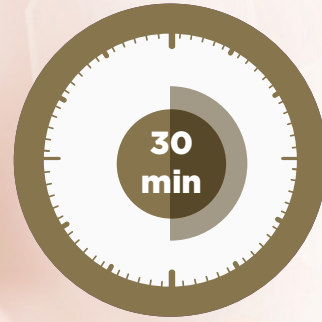

EPIDERMAL BARRIER FUNCTION FOR HEALTHY SKIN

The stratum corneum is the outer layer of skin and is the body's first line of defense against environmental aggressors, a vital barrier to protect the internal cells and tissues and help maintain balanced cellular functions. An impaired structure of the epidermal barrier will trigger inflammatory responses of the body and may lead to extreme conditions of skin such as inflammation and irritation. From an aesthetic point of view dehydrated and dry skin will show accentuated fine lines and wrinkles as well as rough, dull, dry texture.

The stratum corneum principal protective roles are:

- i. Permeability barrier against excess water loss and temperature regulation
- ii. Physical barrier against microorganisms, bacteria
- iii. Mechanical barrier
- iv. UV radiation and oxidative stress protection

The epidermis' permeability barrier is extremely important for healthy, balanced skin as it prevents the excess of water evaporation. TEWL (transepidermal water loss) is defined as the measurement of the quantity of water that passes from inside the body via diffusion and evaporation processes to the atmosphere through the stratum corneum, the outermost layer of the skin. TEWL is one of the parameters that help evaluate the integrity of the epidermal permeability barrier function of the skin. These processes are influenced by many different external and internal factors i.e. humidity, temperature, metabolic activity as well as the incorrect use of topical skin care products that are not suitable for the skin condition, will affect the natural balance of the skin barrier function.

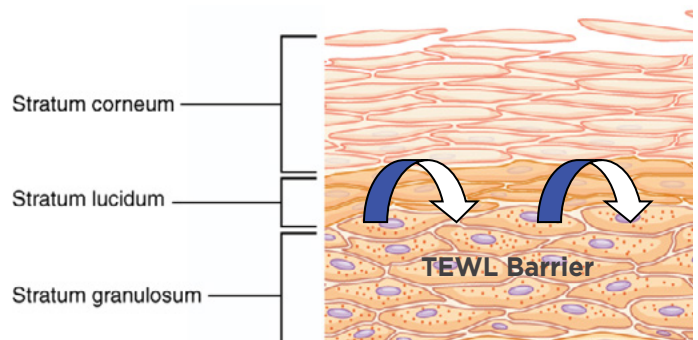
The key actives incorporated in skin care formulations, in various concentrations and ratios, will offer hydration, promote balanced skin barrier activity and prevent excess TEWL that will affect the skin's integrity. The 3 categories of cosmetic actives that combined in topical formulations effectively contribute to fortifying the skin barrier

to prevent undesired and excessive TEWL are:

- A) Humectant agents attract and hold water, each agent has a different skin hydration potential which depends on its water-binding capacity and ability to penetrate into the skin. Some humectant agents occur naturally in the skin and are called NMF (natural moisturizing factors), they help retain water and preserve an optimal permeability barrier minimizing TEWL.
- B) Occlusive agents diffuse into the intercellular lipid layer and act as a barrier preventing the evaporation of water from within the skin into the atmosphere.
- C) Lipids act as boosters and can help repair the damaged skin barrier and thus contribute to minimizing excess TEWL.

In cases where the skin barrier is impaired, it is best to avoid using daily formulations that will further aggravate the condition, for example potential irritants and strong astringents and toners; those can lead to cutaneous irritation and inflammation.

As a first step in the treatment of complexions with a compromised stratum corneum barrier activity is the repair and regulation of the skin's natural protective barrier to prevent accelerated TEWL and aggravate to additional side effects that accompany the condition. Optimizing the skin's moisture level is vital to skin health and important in ensuring a beautiful complexion. Once a healthy and balanced epidermal barrier activity has been reached, a more aggressive skin care regimen can be embarked on according to the client's skin type, condition and desired results.

POLLUTION AND PREMATURE SKIN AGING

Aging is a complex process and our body undergoes multiple aging processes caused by: intrinsic factors (aka chronological aging) resulting from our genetics and extrinsic factors (aka environmental aging) such as the lifestyle choices and habits we adopt throughout our lifetime.

The extrinsic factors that contribute to aging are diverse and are always present on a daily basis; however, their intensity and effect will vary with geographical locations as well as seasons and climate. Among the most significant lifelong environmental factors are UV radiation, temperature, smoke and air pollution, these all interact with each other as well as may escalate further the effects of the intrinsic aging process. These forementioned environmental factors bring about free radicals damage that will damage skin cells, cause dehydration and disruption of a normalized cellular activity which over time leads to premature lines, uneven skin tone, loss of firmness and elasticity.

Dermatological research has shown that

environmental factors are involved in the development of age related changes¹ and that both external and internal factors as well as their interactions lead to biological and clinical signs of skin aging². The correlation between unprotected UV exposure, skin damage and aging has been supported for decades however in the past few years, more attention is given to the effects of pollution on our bodies and in particular how it may affect the skin aging. Different studies have concluded that exposure to unhealthy levels of ozone pollution contributes to signs of aging because of decreasing collagen leading to wrinkles, loss of elasticity, discoloration and saggingness.

While air pollution may be difficult to escape, there are steps to counteract its negative effects on the skin and overall health. By adopting a correct skincare regimen that includes potent skin-nourishing and antioxidant ingredients, formulations that improve skin barrier function and the diligent application of broad-spectrum UV sunscreen daily can help minimize the harmful effects of pollution on the skin and delay the premature appearance of age signs.
